ST PATRICK'S DAY

St Patrick's Day began as a celebration of St Patrick himself. He was born in England and, at age 16, was taken hostage by some Irish raiders who attacked his family's estate. He was then held captive in Ireland for 6 years, during which time he became a devout catholic. After this time, he escaped to England and later returned to Ireland as a missionary intent on converting the Irish to Christianity. St Patrick's Day is now celebrated on March 17th, the day St Patrick is believed to have died in the year 493. A national holiday in Ireland, parades and events are generally themed green with lots of traditional Irish dance, music, food and drink. The first parade was held in USA in 1937 when Irish soldiers in the British army marched through the streets of Boston.
